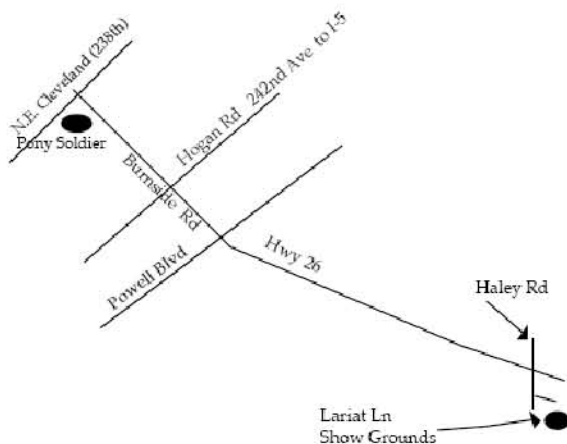

~GENERAL REGULATIONS~

Awards: All classes tied through 6th Place

Rules: Every class offered herein is covered by the rules & specifications of the current USEF Equestrian Rule Book and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Age: The age of an individual on Dec 1, 2009 is maintained for the entire year. For horse show purposes a horse becomes one year old on Jan. 1 following actual foaling date.

Amateur: To enter classes for amateurs, current USEF or application must be given to show secretary at least one hour prior to classes.

Changes: Show management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes with less than 3 entries. An equitation class that does not fill may be combined with the next qualifying age group. Management may also move a class in accordance with USEF rules. Exhibitors will be notified if classes are combined, cancelled, or moved. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to notify the show office in the event of a scratched entry.

Conduct: Show management reserves the right to reject any entry of any exhibitor, or the participation of any agent/trainer/rider that shows unsportsmanlike behavior.

DOGS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO RUN LOOSE. Your co-operation is appreciated.

Entries: Must be plainly printed or typed and signed by owner or authorized agent. A parent must sign entry of a junior exhibitor. Entries will not be accepted without entry and stall fees.

PRE-ENTRY CLOSES MARCH 10th, 2010

~NO SMOKING IN THE BARN~

Exhibitors: All exhibitors must ride in suitable show ring attire, with correct number on their backs, and clearly visible to the judge.

Gate Holds: Holds are to be requested with the paddock manager before the start of the performance and will be instituted at the discretion of the paddock manager. The gate will be closed 2 minutes after the 1st horse has entered the ring. No horses will be allowed to enter the ring after the gate is closed.

Post Entries: All entries postmarked after March 10th will be charged a post entry fee. Post entries will be accepted at the show until the performance has started. All post entries must be registered at the show office and will not be accepted at the gate.

Protests: All protests must be written, signed, and addressed to the Show Secretary, received by the Show Manager, Secretary or member of the show committee within 48 hours of the alleged occurrence of violation and with the appropriate fee.

Loss and Injury: The NWSA, NWSA Board of Directors, MHEEC, their members and associates will not be responsible for any loss, damages or injury to horses, or any article of any kind that may be lost or destroyed, or in any way injured. Each exhibitor/owner/agent will be responsible for any injury that may occur to any person, by any horse exhibited by him/her and shall identify the aforementioned organization and individual against all claims and demands of any kind or nature that may grow out of injury occasioned by any horse owned by him or her, or arise from the negligence of the person in charge of any such horse. All horses will be exhibited at the owners' risk. Submitting an entry shall constitute acceptance of all provisions as set forth herein. The NWSA and the MHEEC and all their associates cannot be held liable for loss or injury to person or property of any visitor, guest, or spectator.

Refunds: Refunds of entries will be made upon receipt of a veterinarian certificate stating the nature of the injury or illness and presented prior to the horses first class. A \$25.00 office fee will be charged. All refunds will be mailed after the show.

RV Hook-up: Electrical hook-ups are available at first come first serve basis. Restrooms with showers are available on the grounds. A dump station is available at the Flying J Truck Stop in Troutdale.

Office Hours: The show office will open one hour prior to the start of each performance and will close at the conclusion of the last class of each session.

Returned Checks: All checks returned for non-payment will be assessed a \$25.00 handling fee and must be replaced by Money Order, Cashier's Check, or Cash.

Registration number and full registered name are required for entry in classes for registered horses. Saddlebred horses must send a copy of registration papers with the entry form.

Important: Signatures required

I also hereby hold harmless NWSA, the NWSA Board & MHEEC from any and all liability on account of loss, damage, or injury that I or any person whom I allow upon MHEEC premises or into the stall rented to me and mine suffer, and agree to hold NWSA, the NWSA Board & MHEEC harmless therefrom. I hereby certify that every equine is eligible as entered. I make these entries at my own risk and subject to the rules of this show and I agree to be bound thereby.
