www.horshowsonline.com Online Entry Instructions

You will need:

- An account at HorseShowsOnline. Basic member accounts are FREE and can be created at www.horshowsonline.com.
- A record in your account for each person and horse that you will use on show entry forms when you enter a show. People and horses you create in your account are saved permanently and can be used in other shows you enter - you only need to add them once!

Getting started:

1. Log in to HorseShowsOnline by clicking the "Member Services" button in the main menu.
2. Once you are logged in, click the "My Horses, People, Shows" button in the Member Menu.
3. At the "People, Horses, Shows" page, add any new people and horses to your account as required on the appropriate tab (i.e., "My People", or "My Horses"). People and horses are saved with your account. Once you have those records in your account you can use them at every show you enter.
4. Click the "Enter Show" button to select the show you want to enter, and follow the steps in the online entry wizard.

Steps to enter a show:

1. Select the show you want to enter from your "My People, Horses, Shows" page on the "My Show Entries" tab, or find the show you want to enter in the Show Selector and click the Online Entry icon. This will start the online entry wizard. Make sure you have already created the horses and people in your member account.
2. The online entry wizard will guide you through the steps to complete the entry form. The basic steps in the wizard are:
 - Select the horse, people, and riders for your entry
 - Select the classes each rider is entered in
 - Select the quantity of stalls and other fees
 - Confirm your selections
 - Checkout and submit the show entry
 - 'USE ZEROS in fields requiring numbers if a person/horses isn't required to have the number. For instance, classes don't have to have USEF numbers
3. The final step generates the completed entry form and submits our entry to the show for review and acceptance. If the show requires a payment at entry time, you will be prompted for your credit card information.

Note: You can cancel the entry part way through the Wizard and resume the entry later on. Unfinished entry forms are listed in your "My Entries" tab and will allow you to edit the entry.

Any questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Executive Committee. Their decision is final. The Horse Show Executive Committee shall include the Chairman of the NWSA Fall Classic and Futurity Horse Show, Horse Show Manager, Horse Show Secretary, and the President of NWSA.

The NWSA Fall Classic and Futurity Horse Show reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel any entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages.

The NWSA Fall Classic and Futurity Horse Show reserves the right to cancel or consolidate classes in which there are insufficient entries, and change class order to facilitate time schedule and conditions with due notice to exhibitors.

Judging will be based on a single judge system. The NWSA Fall Classic & Futurity Horse Show reserves the privilege of substituting or changing judges if necessary. The Show Committee accepts no responsibility for the judges' decisions in the show ring.

All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to barns or other properties on the show grounds, and will be billed accordingly.

Dogs: All dogs must be under leash control at all times.

No competition numbers will be released by the Show Office until all entry blanks are completed, signed, membership cards presented, and all necessary registration papers and measurement cards have been seen. In addition to payment in full, a signed open check must be deposited with the Show Office.

All entries are accepted with the understanding that the NWSA Fall Classic and Futurity Horse Show will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the horse show committee, but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned to him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify the NWSA Fall Classic and Futurity Horse Show against any and all loss, damage and liability

thus occasioned including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of a signed entry form shall constitute an acceptance by each person admitting knowledge and understanding of the provisions set forth herein. In addition to entries of persons suspended or expelled from the Association, the recognized competition may refuse any entry of an exhibitor or the participation of any agent, trainer, rider, driver or handler who has shown an objectionable attitude towards the recognized competition or to its management.

Entry forms must: be signed by the exhibitor, rider, driver, handler, coach (if applicable) and trainer or agent. For riders under the age of 18, parent or guardian, or if not available, the trainer must sign an entry on the minor's behalf; Be made on an entry form provided by the show; Show the correct mailing address and phone number of owner, rider and trainer.

ENTRIES CLOSE SEPTEMBER 12, 2022. Entries received after that date will be charged an additional late fee of \$20 per horse.

Returned Checks/Invalid credit cards: Checks returned by the bank for any reason will incur a \$35 charge per check, or 10% of the check, whichever is greater. No checks will be processed through the bank a second time. A \$10 charge will be assessed each time a new or existing credit card has to be run to obtain payment.

Scratches and Rider Changes: All scratches and rider changes MUST be made in the Horse Show Office BEFORE each performance.

Cancellation and Refunds: Show Management will refund all entries cancelled prior to September 12, 2022. After that time and up to 10 days prior to the show, fees will be refunded less a \$55 processing fee and office fee. Entries cancelled after that time will require a veterinarian's statement. There will be no refunds after the start of the show.

Awards and prize money: Awards 1st place, ribbons to 6th place. Futurity prize money will be paid by the NWSA Futurity.

Stake Classes: No need to qualify for Stake classes.

Combined NWSA Futurity and Open ASB 2 Year Old/3 Year Old Classes: Open to NWSA Futurity nominated and non-nominated entries. To be judged as one class. Futurity payback awarded to nominated entries according to placement in class. No fee for nominated entries. If a trainer has a nominated and non-nominated entry in the same class, the class will be split.

Stabling: Stalls with full doors are available from 8 AM Tuesday, September 20 through the following Sunday morning at \$150 per stall, with no bedding included. All early arrivals prior to September 20 will be charged an additional \$35 per/day. No straw bedding is allowed on the grounds. Each horse must be assigned to a separate stall (exception:

broodmares with suckling foals). Horses must be placed in stalls assigned. Day stalls, if available are \$55 per day. For those who haul in and do not purchase a stall, there will be a \$35 per day, per horse charge. Horses on the grounds overnight must be stalled.

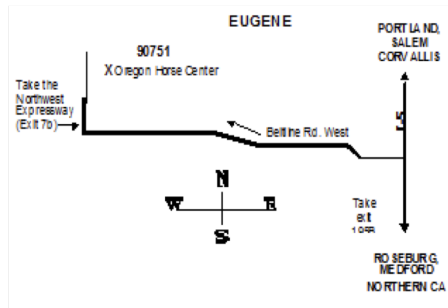

Futurity In Hand Classes

Futurity in hand classes to be held virtually with performance videos uploaded to Youtube Channel: **NWSA – In Hand Futurity** (going live on September 1). Videos should be between 2-5 minutes, preferably less. All competing videos must be received by September 15.

1. Entries will be judged in accordance with USEF guidelines for in hand classes (excerpted below):

SB173 Appointments (see also SB104) 1. Entries to be led in the ring and shown in bridle or halter without quarter boots, blinkers, blindfolds or other appliances. PROHIBITED: Curb bits and tail sets on weanlings and yearlings. © USEF 2022 SB - 40 2.

SB174 Attendants Only two people per animal are permitted in the ring. Handlers and attendants must be neatly and appropriately dressed in clean and well-fitted clothes. Each may carry or use a whip not exceeding 6' including lash; the lash shall not have been altered in any way except no more than two ribbon streamers attached that are eight inches or less in length. It must be a standard whip of suitable style.

SB175 Judging Procedures 1. Conformation and finish count 50% of the total score. All entries should be judged according to the standards for the ideal American Saddlebred/Half American Saddlebred type and conformation. Defects must be penalized. Way of going and natural action count 50% of the total score. Labored way of going to be severely penalized.

2. Placings to be announced at 5:00 pm Friday, prior to the evening performance.
